
#### Old Business

- Discussion of zoning letters sent last month. 46312 Dove and 14546 Buck returned – going to remail certified. 46909 is okay with building permit but wanted the fine waived – no change in fine. Also to send letter to Krone property on Fox/Tower with container violation.
- Discussion of Abby Lane gate – Justin made a motion to table the gate issue until the attorney is contacted to see if legal, seconded by Grayling. All agreed.
- Road Flags – Betty made flags with fabric to attach to lathe.
- Trent Rabe permit – records show permit from 2010, Justin to talk to Trent to see if correct
- Interest on checking account is .05%
- Dead end Dove trees – Dan Rice not contacted, Justin to contact this month.
- Hunter Road – attorney not contacted, Peter Tiede to be contacted this month by Grayling.

#### New Business

- Discussion with Karen Degerstrom regarding plowing of past board members' driveways, not in favor of. Questioning the 3-minute open forum and why the limit. Per board for the length of meeting, otherwise a continuation may be needed.
- Al Toering – wanted to check in with the Township as he has been taking it upon himself to trap the beaver, wanted to make sure we wanted his services.
- Discussion on FEMA – culvert by Grinsteinner's too? Yes, might not be able to be a 36", Justin to talk to Trent to get estimate and what culvert would be best.
- Discussion of voting – over 500 voters and now need to have the omniballet at township elections and order special ballots. Grayling made a motion to also increase election judge pay to \$20/hr (the same as other increases), seconded by Justin. All agreed.
- Discussion of chloride on Dove- this would be the 2<sup>nd</sup> year. To discuss again next month.
- File cabinet for zoning – Betty to check on cabinet she has to see if it has a key and go from there.
